~ CALL FOR ARTISTS ~

*The NEAFA 2011 Calendar Preview* will be a showcase of the semi-finalists' work which will adorn next years' calendar. From this body of work, our jurors will choose 14 pieces; one for each month, one for January of the following year, and lastly, the prestigious cover. Three of the 14 spots available will be dedicated to young artists in Grades K-3, 4-6, and 7-12. The public will vote on their favorites during the course of the show and their votes, along with those of the jurors, will determine the final content of the NEAFA 2011 Calendar. The winners will be announced the first week of April 2010. *The NEAFA Arts Exhibition* will be invitation-only for NEAFA artists as well as a wonderful retrospective of the best work from previous shows. **The following information is for Calendar entrants ONLY.**

~ Up to three pieces of **animal-themed artwork** may be submitted for consideration, with a per-piece entry fee of \$10 for adults and \$5 for children, using the form at the bottom of the page. Artwork may be in any medium including, but not limited to: pencil, pen and ink, oil, acrylic, watercolor, pastel, giclee print, collage, mixed media, sculpture, photography, and computer art. We strongly prefer all images of the artwork to be submitted via CD in jpeg format **only**, 300 DPI, and labeled with the title, medium, size, and price; however, **high-quality** photographs will be accepted. **Please return the completed form with check made payable, and mailed, to: NEAFA, P.O. Box 330, Norwell, MA, 02061.** You will be notified of the jurors' decision via the e-mail or phone number you indicate on the form. If you prefer, include a self-addressed stamped envelope with your entry for notification of the jurors' decision and/or if you want your CD or photographs returned. All entries must be original works of art; anything determined to substantially copy another's work, or be deemed of unsuitable content, will not be considered. **All entries must be postmarked by Feb. 19<sup>th</sup>, 2010!**

~ **If your work is accepted**, the artwork **must** meet the following criteria: pieces must be horizontal and no larger than 30" x 24" framed due to space limitations and requisite calendar format (some sculpture and wall hangings may exceed these dimensions at the discretion of NEAFA); all 2D work shall be properly matted, framed, and wired by the artist (clip-on frames are unacceptable); sculptors must provide their own display pedestals, which must be clean and in presentation condition. Artwork shall remain for the duration of the show and cannot be moved once hung or placed as applicable. The artist, if so desired, is responsible for insuring their artwork. Both NEAFA and Derby Street Shoppes retain the right to remove any piece, at any time, at their discretion. Neither NEAFA nor Derby Street Shoppes shall bear responsibility for damage or theft of artworks. It is solely the artist's responsibility to deliver and pick up their artwork at The Derby Street Shoppes; for directions go to <http://www.thederbystreetshoppes.com>. For each piece sold, artists will receive 50%, and NEAFA 50%, unless the artist desires to donate their portion to NEAFA.
